## PHYSICAL EDUCATION AT THE BLYTH SCHOOL COMMUNITY COLLEGE

As you are probably aware Physical Education is a compulsory subject within the National Curriculum for every student up until the end of Year 11. As a result the P.E. Department of TBSCC offers a varied curriculum through which your son can enjoy new experiences / activities as well as revisiting existing skills.

Each lesson will have three main aims for the student:-

- To improve upon their existing skill level.
- To improve their overall cardio-vascular fitness.
- To enjoy physical activity.

All that is asked of each student is that they try their best at all times no matter what the activity may be.

In order that these aims can be met successfully and so that your son is safe at all times certain rules and regulations have to be followed:-

- Each student **MUST** come to the P.E. lesson fully prepared with the correct kit as outlined overleaf.

### **PLEASE READ CAREFULLY THE REQUIREMENTS AND ENSURE THAT YOUR SON IS ABLE TO MEET THEM FOR EVERY LESSON.**

- **NO** jewellery is to be worn in the lesson. This is for Health and Safety reasons and includes any type of body piercing, watch, bracelet and earring. If your son wishes to have his ear pierced may we suggest that this is done in the summer holidays so they have time to heal and therefore will not need covering with tape, which he will have to provide.
- If your son has long hair then he must come prepared to tie it back.
- Trainers / Football Boots must be tied correctly to the teacher's satisfaction so that they are safe, not just tucked in.
- No chewing gum / food is to be eaten in the lesson.
- If you wish your son to be excused a lesson then a note from the parent / guardian must be presented. The note should be dated and state clearly what the problem is.

### **As well as the note the student MUST always bring the appropriate PE kit required for the lesson.**

This is done for two reasons:-

- So that the student does not get out of the habit of bringing P.E. kit.
- So the student can take on another role, dependant upon his reason for not taking an active part, in the lesson e.g. umpire OR coach, for which he must be dressed appropriately i.e. P.E. kit.

If your son is unable to meet any of the above requirements then he will be provided with the missing items which will allow him to be involved in the lesson.

We want your son to come to Physical Education fully prepared so that he can get the most out of the lesson and even more importantly **ENJOY** it.

I would ask that, having read this information, you sign below to indicate that you and your son fully understand what is expected of him in P.E. lessons.
