

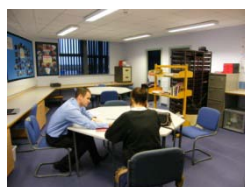


SuccessMaker comprises a portfolio of courses to support both

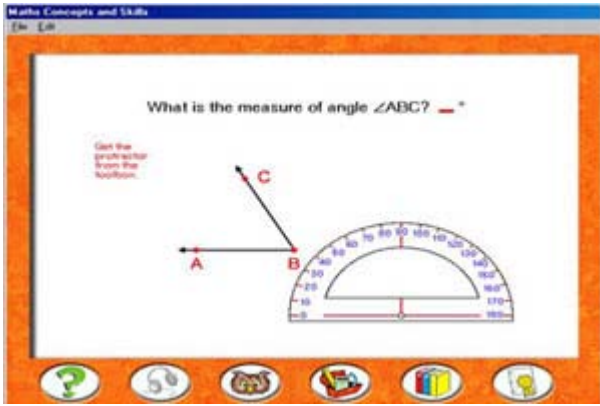

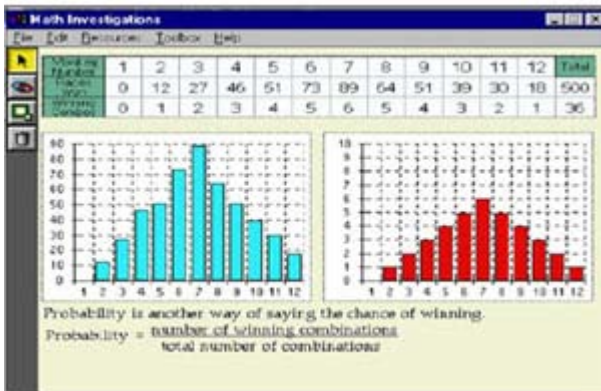

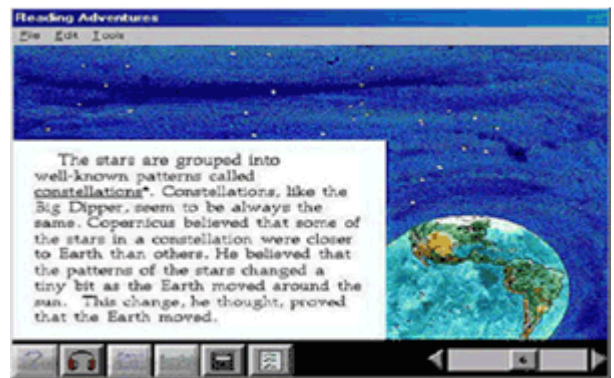
